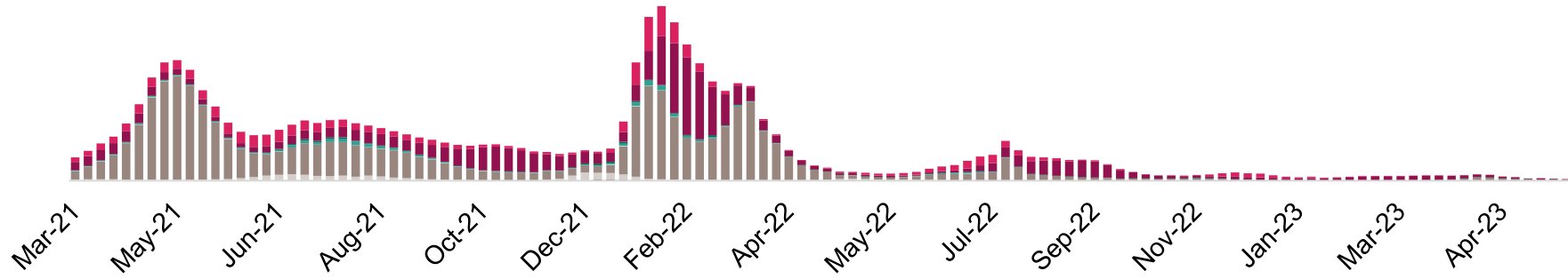

Introduction

C19RM reinvestments and strategic shift

Making the strategic shift in the third phase of C19RM

Number of New COVID-19 Cases

End of COVID-19 as a
public health emergency

1 Emergency Response

In the beginning, **75% of C19RM investments** focused on COVID-19 control and containment. The Global Fund responded quickly to procurement needs based on a solid organizational infrastructure, also providing grant flexibilities. HTM mitigation and urgent improvement to systems for health were also prioritized.

March 2020 – March 2022

- Grant flexibilities
- Acute response
- Fast Track, Full Funding, Additional Funding

2 Pandemic Evolution and Uncertainty

Investments landscape remained unchanged – demand / orders for COVID-19 commodities dropped dramatically but countries did not want to risk reprogramming in case of future surges. Extreme uncertainty delayed continuation of investments by countries.

April 2022 – April 2023

- Started the shift
- Evolved strategic priorities
- Extension of Implementation
- Portfolio Optimization Wave 1

3 Transition to Systems Strengthening

Five strategic priorities: Surveillance systems, laboratory systems, HRH and community systems, medical oxygen and respiratory care, health product and waste management.
Actions to drive the shift: (i) visibility on reinvestment landscape; (ii) maintain urgency and agility in funds deployment; (iii) enhance monitoring and support implementation

May 2023 – December 2023

- Portfolio Optimization Wave 2
- Reinvestment towards Strategic Priorities
- Multi-prong approach to implementation support

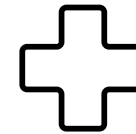

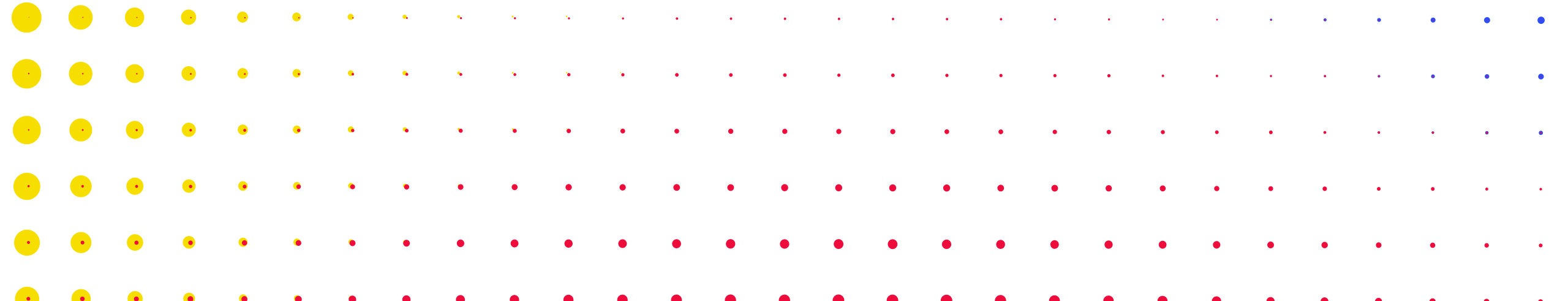

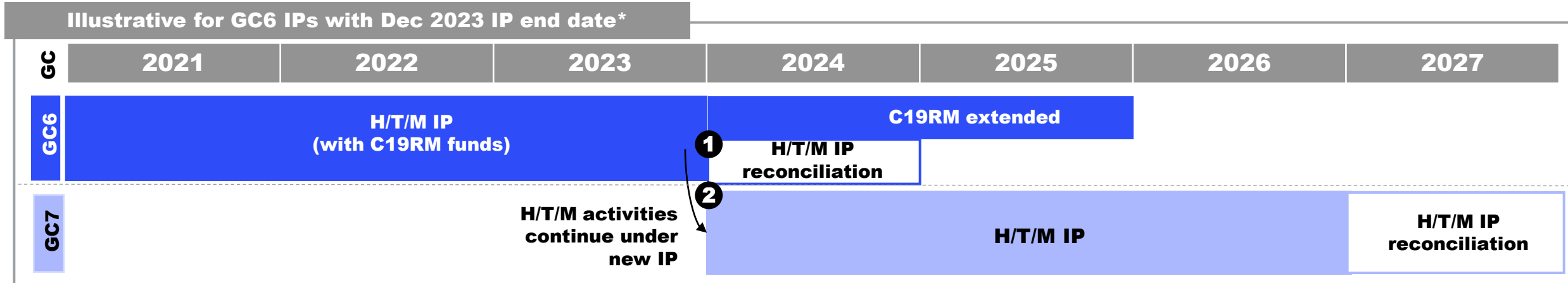

C19RM revisions and next steps



C19RM funds remain in Grant Cycle 6 until the C19RM implementation end date



Nov '22 decision: to extend use of C19RM funds up to Dec '25.

Dec '22 decision: the C19RM component remains in GC6 once the HIV, Tuberculosis, Malaria (HTM) component(s) end.

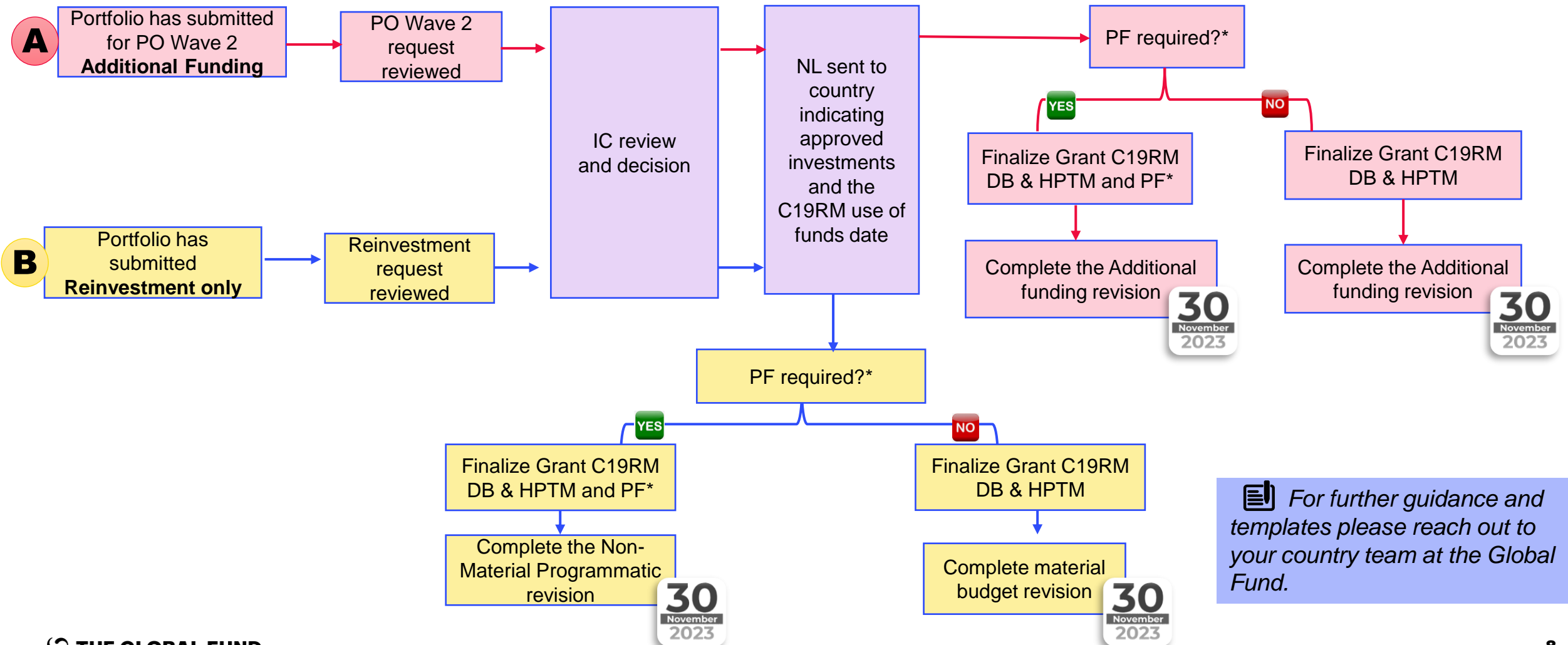
Sep '23 decision: advance disbursements and updated implementation timelines for some countries


What does this mean?

- HTM grant components close per current requirements and implementation continues in GC7.
- C19RM activities are implemented until the C19RM end date, even if the HTM component is in closure.

Portfolios that submitted (a) PO Wave 2 and (b) Reinvestments only

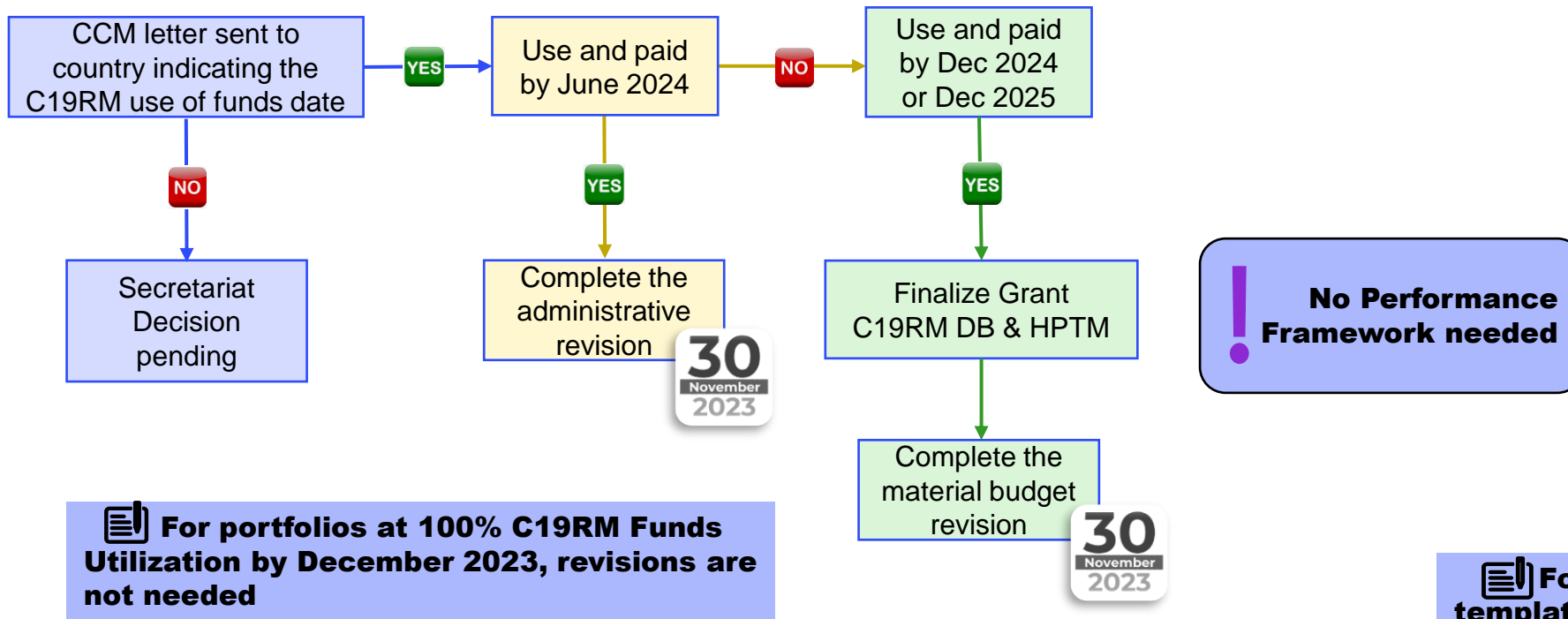

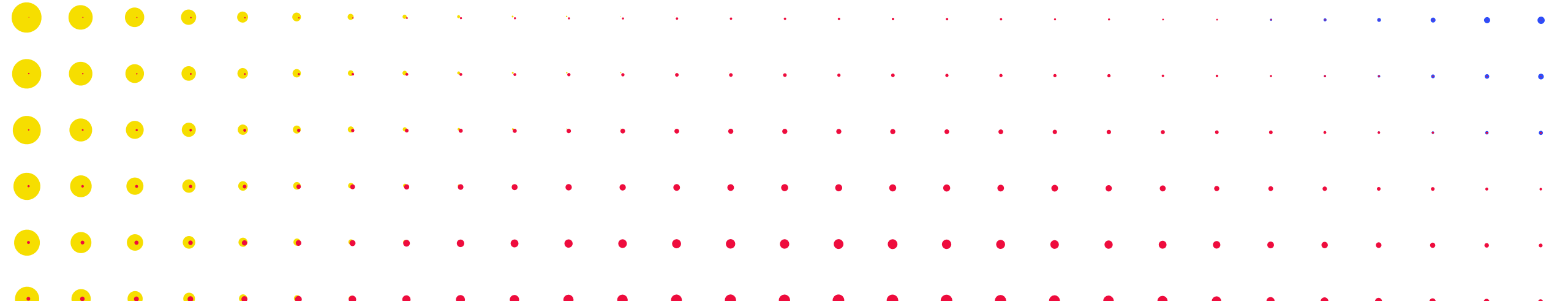

Revision Documents: Access documents shared by the Global Fund, attach the completed documents, and submit in the Portal

C19RM Performance Framework (C19RM PF): Populate the online PF form and submit directly through the Portal (no Excel)

Only C19RM Revisions requiring a PF

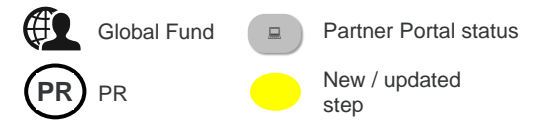


Implementation Letter (IL): Access the IL shared by the Global Fund, attach signed IL, and submit through the Portal

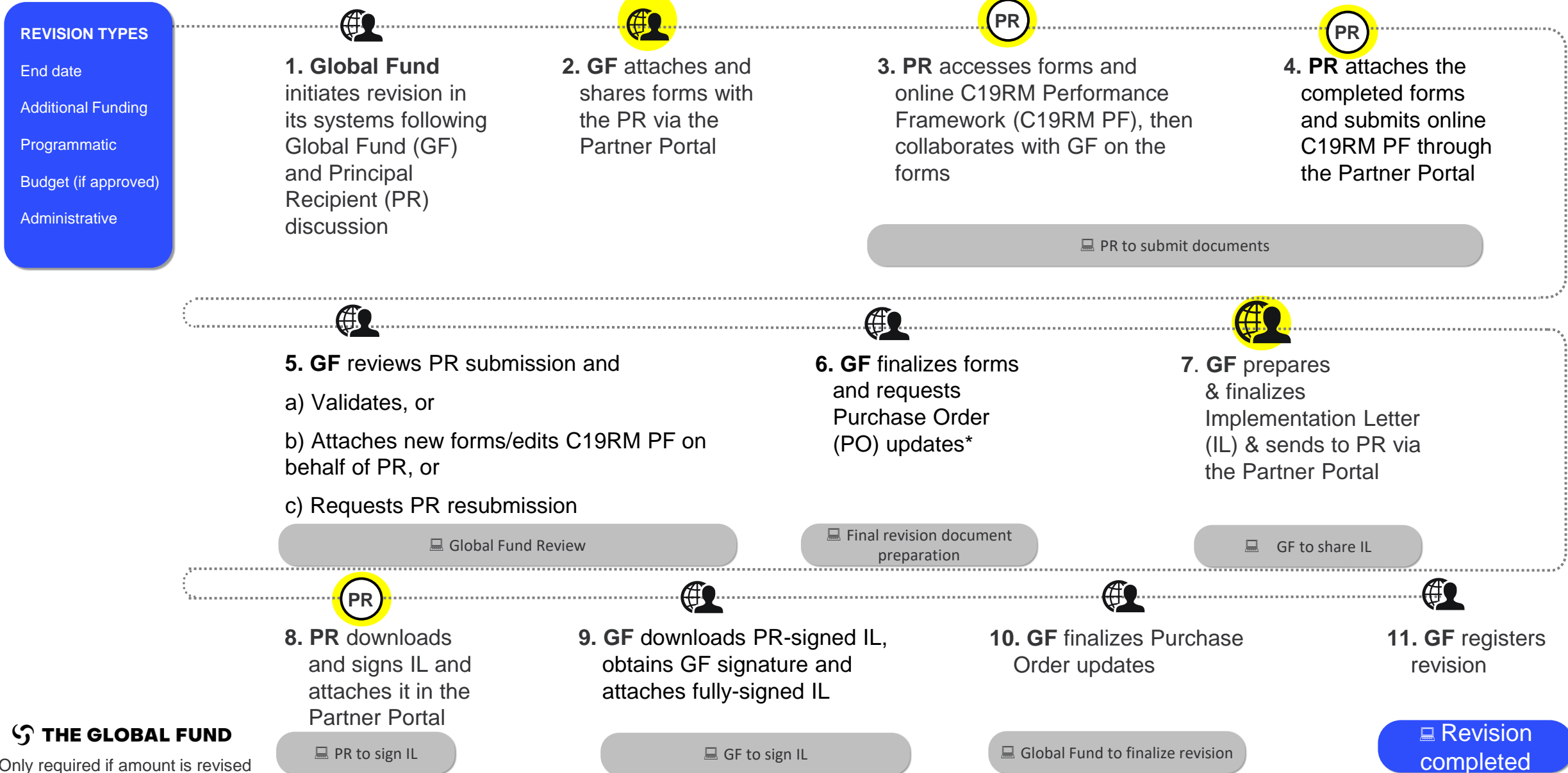

Performance Framework (PF): Must use the Excel version shared by the GF or through the Portal*

Budget: Align with the GF to use the same version used in grant-making or latest version shared by the CT or through the Portal*.

*GC7 grant revisions will be handled through the Partner Portal

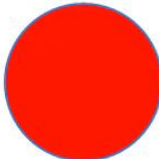
C19RM Budget: An updated form was released in April 2023. If a revision has already been handled with the updated form, align with the GF whether to use that form. If not, use the version shared in the Partner Portal.

C19RM PF: Can only be completed and submitted through an online form. An Excel form is available for collaboration, but this cannot be submitted through the Portal; it is considered an invalid submission.

End date: A new field, 'C19RM funds use date,' has been added to the C19RM PF and Budget. This must match the C19RM Implementation End Date recently communicated to the CCM.

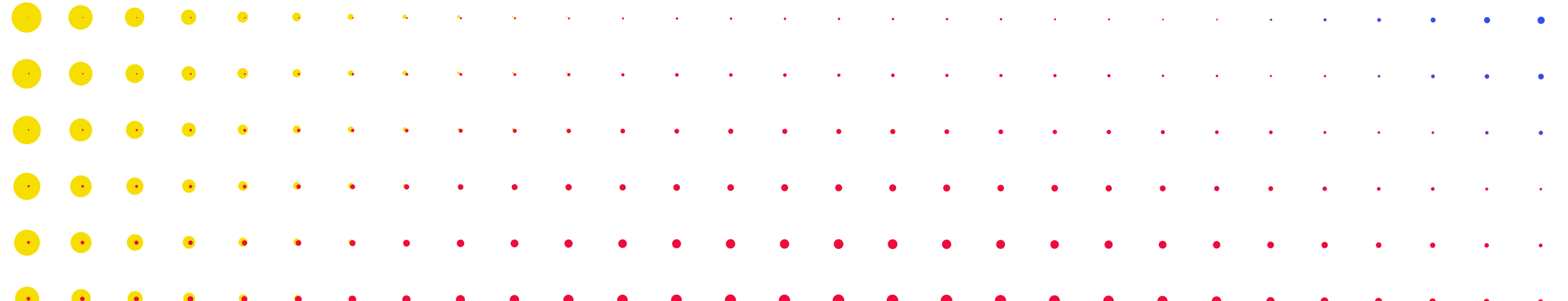

How to access

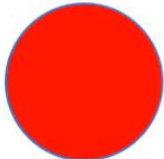
The C19RM PF appears as a separate tab in the Partner Portal for eligible revisions; a C19RM PF is not required for all C19RM revisions.

Important note

The Excel C19RM PF used to apply for additional funds cannot be attached and submitted in the Partner Portal.

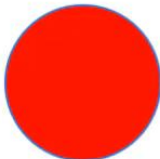
