Malaria and climate change, reprogramming for GC7

The third <u>survey to assess community satisfaction</u> with the funding request process for countries that submitted requests in windows 4-6 is open for communities affected by HIV, tuberculosis or malaria, and civil society representing them. In Arabic, English, French, Portuguese, Spanish and Russian, the survey **can be filled** until 20 December 2024. CCMs and PRs are encouraged to share the survey with communities.
