



# **GC8 PR Nomination Guidance**

# Early PR nomination & Grant Entity Data update



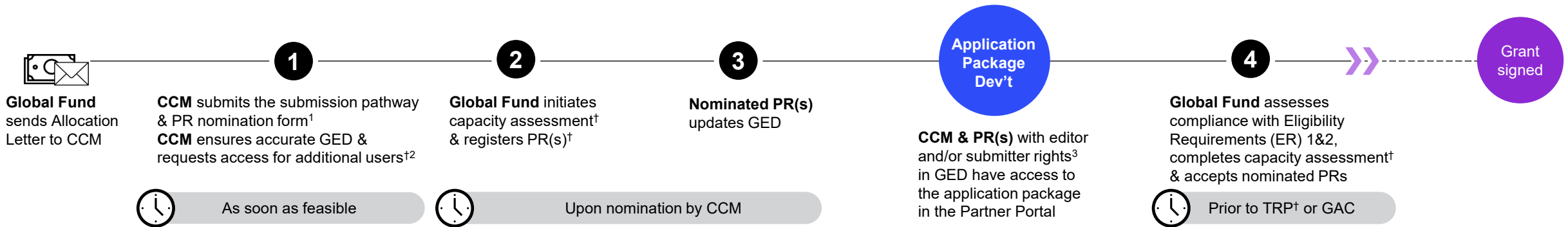
Access to the Partner Portal requires **Grant Entity Data (GED)** to be complete and accurate.



**Early PR nomination** is essential for PRs to complete grant-level documents as part of the application package. It is required for any Grant-ready Funding Request, Investment Priorities Request and Program Continuation Submission, as well as for Classic Funding Requests if PRs need to access the online HPMT.



CCMs planning to register to any 2026 TRP Window<sup>†</sup> confirm their Submission Pathway & TRP Window<sup>†</sup> through the designated form **no later than 30 days** upon receipt of the Allocation Letter. Early PR nomination is required at the same time (i) for 2026 Grant-ready funding requests, (ii) Classic funding Requests if PRs need to access the online HPMT, and (iii) Program Continuation Submission and Investment Priorities Request for portfolios ending in 2026.

# Requirements for nominating PRs in GC8

In assessing compliance with Eligibility Requirement 1 & 2, the Global Fund reserves the right to request the following:

Minutes of CCM meetings where PR nomination is planned, discussed and confirmed. Minutes include (i) a summary of discussions, (ii) a list of participants, (iii) decision points, and (iv) a record of who and which constituency took part in the decision-making process. CCM meeting minutes also demonstrate how conflict of interest was managed.			✓	
Documentation demonstrating (i) a transparent decision process was followed, and (ii) the criteria used for the PR nomination decision.			✓

 The Global Fund does not require CCMs to issue a call for applications if an existing PR is nominated for GC8. CCMs are expected to follow their own process requirements.
